Section 3 – Important Information

It is sometimes difficult to determine whether a motor driven cycle is a moped (scooter) or a motorcycle. The following Georgia laws determine what type of vehicle you own and the type of permit which you will be issued:

Georgia State Laws

O.C.G.A. § 40-1-1-(28) "Moped" means a motor driven cycle equipped with two or three wheels, with or without foot pedals to permit muscular propulsion, and an independent power source providing a maximum of two brake horsepower. If a combustion engine is used, the maximum piston or rotor displacement shall be 3.05 cubic inches (50 cubic centimeters) regardless of the number of chambers in such power source. The power source shall be capable of propelling the vehicle, unassisted, at a speed not to exceed 30 miles per hour (48.28 kilometers per hour) on a level road surface and shall be equipped with a power drive system that functions directly or automatically only, not requiring clutching or shifting by the operator after the drive system is engaged.

O.C.G.A. § 40-1-1-(29) "Motorcycle" means every motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact with the ground, but excluding a tractor, all-terrain vehicle, and moped.

Summary

- Engine displacement greater than 50 cc
- Top speed greater than 30 mph
- Shifting or clutching

If your motor driven cycle meets or exceeds any of the above conditions, you have a motorcycle.

Motorcycles and mopeds improperly registered or improperly parked are subject to fines, booting, and towing.
